The GPSR entered into force on 12 June 2023, and will be applicable from 13 December 2024, replacing the previous General Product Safety Directive. The European Commission is currently drafting guidelines to help economic operators implement the new regulation. Against this background, EY, commissioned by EISMEA and DG JUST, is organizing a one-day, in-person workshop in Brussels in order to collect SME's input on such guidelines.
